



CAREER WITH US DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACY

 Assistant, Associate and Full Professors (Tenure Track) in Pharmaceutical Technology, Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research, Pharmacogenomics or Translational Medicine

Candidates must be a holder of the PhD degree with at least two years of postdoctoral experience. The Bachelor degree in Pharmacy or its equivalent, leading to entry-to-practice as a pharmacist is advantageous. It is also an advantage for the candidates to possess a competitive CV with international publications and have managed previous research grants. The appointed candidates will need to maintain active, extramurally-funded research programme/s while teaching modules for undergraduates and postgraduates. Start-up packages with dedicated laboratory facilities will be provided.

Assistant, Associate and Full Professors (Tenure Track) in Clinical Pharmacy

Candidates must be holder of the PharmD degree which is recognized for pharmacist registration with the Singapore Pharmacy Council, as well as two or more years of postgraduate training such as residency, fellowship or relevant work experience in teaching and clinical service. Candidates with US board certification and/or evidence of scholarship is an advantage. International publications at the entry-point and an inclination for research with extramural funding are preferred. The appointed candidates will provide clinical service/s in specialty area/s and demonstrate clinical/professional leadership as well as teach/mentor undergraduates and postgraduates via didactics, clerkship, preceptorship and/or research programmes.

Lecturer, Senior Lecturer and Associate Professor (Non Tenurable Educator Track) in

- Clinical Pharmacy (General Medicine, Cardiology, Psychiatry or Geriatrics),
 - Pharmacy Practice (Community Pharmacy or Regulatory Affairs)

Candidates must possess either the PhD or PharmD degree with relevant work experience. PharmD degree holders must be eligible for licensure with the Singapore Pharmacy Council. The Bachelor degree in Pharmacy or its equivalent, leading to entry-to-practice as a pharmacist is advantageous. The appointed candidates will teach/supervise undergraduates and postgraduates via didactics, clerkship, preceptorship and/or projects, as well as lead in the development of teaching materials and research in pedagogy.

• Part-time Faculty (Tutor, Lecturer, Pharmacy Practice Tutor, Pharmacy Practice Lecturer) in **Pharmaceutical** Sciences, Clinical Pharmacy (General Medicine, Cardiology, Psychiatry or Geriatrics), Pharmacy Practice (Community Pharmacy or Regulatory Affairs)

Candidates must possess either a good Bachelor, Masters, PhD or PharmD degree with relevant work experience. PharmD degree holders must be eligible for licensure with the Singapore Pharmacy Council. The Bachelor degree in Pharmacy or its equivalent, leading to entry-to-practice as a pharmacist is advantageous. The appointed candidates will teach/supervise undergraduates and postgraduates via didactics, clerkship, preceptorship and/or projects

• Manager/Senior Manager

Candidates must possess good organization skills, good report and minutes writing ability, a Bachelor degree in Pharmacy is advantageous. The appointed candidates will plan and organize meetings, seminars, events, admission interviews, PharmD clerkship, and undergraduate pre-employment clinical training programme.
