1	Who can apply for the SkillsFuture Study Award for Healthcare sector?
	The SkillsFuture Study Award for Healthcare sector is open to Singaporeans with at least two years of working experience in the Healthcare sector, including those working in the public sector, private sector or Voluntary Welfare Organisations (VWOs).
	Staff in the Ministry of Health and the Statutory Boards (namely the Health Promotion Board, Health Science Authority and the respective healthcare Professional Boards and Councils) will not be eligible for this study award. They can tap on existing training funds within their respective organisations for skills upgrading.

2	If the course I would like to apply for is not in the list of examples of supported courses, can I still apply for it?
	We are open to consider other local courses that are not included in the list of examples, if they are assessed to be able to help you develop skills and knowledge under the supported training areas of (i) Aged Care, (ii) Healthcare IT and Data Analytics, as well as (iii) Healthcare System Design, Organisation and Delivery. Local conferences, workshops and seminars can also be considered, if they are assessed to be of quality and are relevant to the supported training areas.
3	Can I apply for more than one course? How do I do it?
	You can apply for up to three courses as long as the total training costs are at least \$2,500. The costs can include the course registration fee, course fees, costs for books/materials and other compulsory expenses, on top of any government course fee subsidies.

No. The study award is only applicable to applicants who have yet to start the course or are in the midst of the course at the point of application.
Would I receive the study award amount directly? Or would it be given to my sponsoring employer?
The study award amount will be given directly to you. You will receive 50% of the award (i.e. \$2,500) after we have received documentary proof of your course(s) acceptance (e.g. course acceptance letter from training institution, confirmation of course placement).
You will receive the remaining 50% of the study award after we have received documentary proof of your course(s) completion (e.g. transcript, certificate of completion). Please submit your documentary proof of your course completion no later than two months after completion to mohh.sfsa@mohh.com.sg. To facilitate the identification of your application, please indicate clearly your application number (e.g. MOH-201XXXXX-XXXXXXXX) and your full name within the email subject line.
Do I have to return the award monies if I drop out from the course(s)?
In the event that you do not complete the course(s), you are required to notify MOHH at mohh.sfsa@mohh.com.sg no later than one month from the last date of course attendance. MOH reserves the right to claw back the \$2,500 disbursed to you in the first tranche.
