PSS – DCH AURIGA SINGAPORE COMMUNITY PHARMACIST OF THE YEAR (2021)

Objectives

- To give due recognition to pharmacists who have excelled in the practice of community pharmacy.
- To identify leaders/role models in community pharmacy.
- To encourage and promote excellence in the pharmacy profession.

Attributes of Nominee

- Mentors junior pharmacists and staff and demonstrates leadership qualities.
- Is actively involved in community-based practice research/quality improvement projects. Publications will be accorded higher consideration.
- Has contributed significantly to his/her organization in the area of community pharmacy practice.
- Significant contributions to PSS will be accorded higher consideration.

Eligibility & Nomination Procedure

- Nominations will need to be supported by 2 PSS members.
- The nominee must be a registered pharmacist with the Singapore Pharmacy Council and a PSS member, with at least three years (full time) of local working experience in community pharmacy. (excluding pre-registration training).
- Nominations must be made on the prescribed Nomination Form, and submitted together with:
 - Curriculum Vitae of the nominee.
 - Letter of support / endorsement from his/her senior, supervisor or manager.
- All nominations must be submitted by 15th May 2021.
- Completed forms with accompanying documentation should be emailed to <u>admin@pss.org.sq</u>.

Judging

Evaluation will be made by a panel of judges appointed by PSS. During the judging process, shortlisted nominees may be interviewed by the panel in June 2021. The judges' decision is final.

Presentation of Award

The winner will be announced at the presentation ceremony during the 20th Asian Conference on Clinical Pharmacy (ACCP 2020/21) in July 2021. The award comprises of S\$1,000 in cash, free PSS membership for 1 year and a plaque.
