SECOND INTAKE FOR UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA MASTER OF CLINICAL PHARMACY IS NOW OPEN

The University of South Australia (UniSA) and the National Healthcare Group (NHG) have tied up to introduce a Master of Clinical Pharmacy Programme which will help boost the quality of clinical pharmacists in Singapore since 2005.

The course will further equip clinical pharmacists with the knowledge and skills to perform clinical pharmacy work, gives opportunity for personal upgrading, as well as enhancing the professionalism of clinical pharmacists in Singapore. This part-time course is aimed at working pharmacists and can be completed within a period of two and a half years if no retake. The Singapore course module has been customized to meet local requirements.

Students need to complete 54 units of study before they are awarded the Master of Clinical Pharmacy by UniSA. The courses in the programme, which comprise intensive workshop of lectures; tutorials and case based clinical scenarios will be conducted at NHG College by UniSA staff.

The second course intake is now open and the programme will commence in July 2007.
