

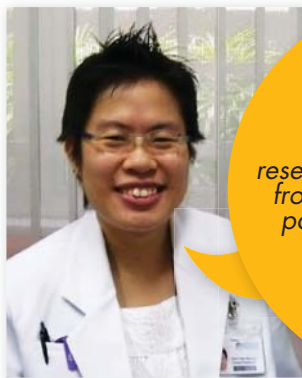

## 1. Senior Pharmacist/ Pharmacist (Full-time/ Part-time/ Locum)
